**Meeting Minutes:** Minutes from previous meeting, 06/18/15 presented for comment. No comments made, motion to approve minutes Karen, seconded by Shawna, approved.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Fiscal year ended June 30. – We ended -\$9,885.00 due to buying of truck and paying tax accountant fees from Pearl Harbor but overall we spent \$3000 more than we earned last year.

Band Club Account (where your fees go to) \$10,664.04 but all of that will be used for major travel payments coming due.

Angie: Band fees do not come to the IMB program, they go to the club account that is managed by the WHS office. This covers staff, travel and some large expenses. We NEED to make sure that everyone is paying their band fees. If you have a hardship, contact Angie and we can work it out. Marching Band scholarships were approved tonight and everyone will be notified. This scholarship will cover ½ of the fees. 9 alumni who ran Jr band camp will be given \$100 scholarships paid from the fees from Jr band camp.

**Directors Report:**

- Ms. Jones: Very happy with #'s for Jr band camp, 11 kids. Performance today at 4 was really fun. Brian Thompson helped them out and facilitated but the techs really ran it. Great experience had by all. It wasn't the logistical problem we thought it might be. MB is working really hard, many are hurting so keep an eye on them. Part 1 is "done" but needs polish 2, 3, and 4 hoping to be done by the end of august camp. There is a rehearsal on the Saturday of Labor Day and we really need to keep that rehearsal. They only have one other Saturday before competition and so we need that. Please make sure that any absence has paperwork that has been turned in to Ms. Jones.

**Committee Reports:**

- **Pit Crew** – This group helps the band get on and off the field. Looking for helpers, contact Dave Saelens if you can help with this.
- **Props** – Rod shared out the pictures for the props this year. There will be 10 – 12ft, 10ft, and 8ft. tall pillars in various stages of ruin, will turn and have mirrors on one side. They will be light and easy to move.
