- Indoor Percussion and Guard Performances – Season is over. Both Battery and Color Guard had a successful season.

 - Hoping to have the times/days of the performances 60 days in advance
- Festival Results- Both groups played at grade 5. Orchestra earned a superior rating and Band earned an excellent rating
- 2019 Marching Band
 - The show is currently being written
 - There will be no large props
 - There will be new staff this year including Amy Merritt from Towson for color guard
 - Pit will be getting a new mixing board and speakers
- Side-By-Side Concert – We hosted 260 elementary and middle school students
- CCPS Solo & Ensemble Festival Results
 - There were 14 groups/soloists performing. 8 earned a 1 - superior rating, 6 earned a 2 - excellent rating
