Mattress Sale Fundraiser Saturday May 18 from 10 – 5 in the high school gymnasium

- Mr. Frazier introduced Scott Fenwick from the Mattress Sales Group, who presented an overview of the fundraiser
 - CFS takes care of everything except word-of-mouth advertising
 - Students who refer buyers will receive a cash incentive
 - Delivery is now included in the price of the mattress and will occur approx. 2-2 ½ weeks after the sale. There will be a \$25 fee to haul old mattresses
 - Beds are made after purchase
